Waiver of Liability

IN CONSIDERATION OF my minor child/ward named above("my child"), being allowed to participate in any way in the A.U.F.A.A. Lacrosse Program, related events and other Allentown Upper Freehold Athletic Association ("A.U.F.A.A.") activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

- The risk of injury to my child from the activities involved in these programs is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,
- For myself, spouse, and child, I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the releases or others, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation; and,
- I willingly agree to comply with the program's stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child's readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove my child from the participation and bring such attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
- I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release the other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Releasees"), with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property incident to my child's involvement or participation in these programs, whether arising from the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
- I, for myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby indemnify and hold harmless all the above Releasees from any and all liabilities incident to my involvement or participation in these programs, even if arising from their negligence, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

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UPPER FREEHOLD TOWNSHIP ATHLETIC CODE OF CONDUCT

(Taken from Upper Freehold Township Ordinance 187-07)

Preamble:

Interscholastic and youth sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social and emotional development of children. It is therefore essential for parents, coaches, and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the value of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control.

I therefore pledge to be responsible for my words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform my behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. I will not engage, nor will I encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in un-sportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
2. I will not engage, nor will I encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
3. I will not encourage or use, nor will I permit my child, or any other person, to encourage or use drugs or alcohol at a youth sports event.
4. I will not encourage, nor permit my child, or encourage any other person, to attend, coach, officiate, or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
5. I will treat and encourage my child to treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, or ability.
6. I will not engage, nor will I encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in the use of profanity.
7. I will not engage, nor will I encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
8. I will not initiate, nor encourage my child, or any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.

I hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a youth sports event I will be subject to disciplinary action issued by a league, organization, or school official who is authorized to issue such action by a school board or youth sports organization, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination there of:

1. Verbal warning issued by a league, organization or school official.
2. Written warning issued by a league, organization or school official.
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth sports event.
4. Suspension for multiple youth sports events.
5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension.

All of the above will be submitted in writing to the school board, the Upper Freehold Township Recreation Committee, and distributed to each youth sports organization.

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Dragons Lacrosse Work Bond Program

Parent Contribution is vital to the success of the Dragons Lacrosse program. The efforts and assistance of the parents is a key element in the ongoing success of the program. While there are currently no fundraising requirements, there is a significant need for the assistance of the parents in preparing and maintaining the fields each spring and throughout the season. One payment per family of \$50 is due for the work bond program. All payments are due prior to uniforms being distributed. Unless otherwise requested, all Work bond checks for families that have satisfied their field duties will be destroyed at the end of the season. Families that have not met their field duty requirements will have their Work Bonds cashed at the end of the year.

Work Bond Requirement

Activities; Each of the below activities will count towards satisfying the work bond requirements. All equipment will be provided for all activities

- Scorers' Table – Keeping the score, game time clock, and managing the penalty timers. Each game should have two parents at the Scorers' Table, one for game clock and score, the other for penalty timer.
- Statistician – Responsible for tracking on-field action and provide statistics for weekly newspaper article submission. The parent is not responsible for writing the articles, just collecting game time information to provide to the coach.
- Weekly Field Duty – Repainting the lines on the field prior to home games. The lines on the field need to be re-painted prior to each home game. This takes about forty-five minutes and can occur during the week while practice is occurring or at least 2 hours prior to game time on the day of the game.
- Seasonal Field Duty – Assist with setting up fields, goals and general field maintenance at the beginning and end of season. The league will coordinate a day in March to setup the fields and a day in June to put everything away. Attendance at only one of these days is required
- Picture Day – Help coordinate the activities around Picture day, including handing out and collecting the forms, organizing the players, and handing out the pictures once they are delivered to us. This will require one parent per team.
- Picnic Duty - Help coordinate the activities around the End-of-Year Picnic. This will involve one or two parents per team to coordinate bringing supplies for the picnic and setting up and breaking down the picnic area.

Due to the number of hours the Managers and Coaches dedicate to the program, they are waived from Work Bond requirements. Parents are responsible for signing in when performing the work bond duties. A master list will be provided to each manager and it is your duty to check in with them and sign in. The A.U.F.A.A. is not responsible for returning Work Bonds if you fail to sign in with your manager.
